## WHY ALUMINUM TABS?

Our partner, Consolidated Scrap Resources, Inc., buys the tabs and sends a check to us! They generously donate their pick-up and handling services, bringing in vital funds that help keep families together.

## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE ALUMINUM TAB PROGRAM?

ANYONE! Many schools support this project because it provides a terrific opportunity for children to get involved and make a genuine contribution to their community. Hospitals, service clubs and also participate in this easy program.

## DO I NEED TO COLLECT A CERTAIN AMOUNT OR COUNT THE ALUMINUM TABS?

No. although some schools make a math or science project out of collecting a million, we will take as many as you gather.

## WHY NOT THE WHOLE CAN?

ALUMINUM tabs are clean, compact, easy to collect and the high-grade aluminum in the tab has a higher recycling value than the aluminum in the rest of the can.

## HOW MUCH IS AN ALUMINUM TAB WORTH?

The price of aluminum changes on a regular basis depending on the supply and demand. On average, we receive around 40 cents per pound of aluminum tabs. It takes around 1,400 tabs to equal 1 pound.

## DO I NEED TO COLLECT THE ALUMINUM TABS IN A SPECIAL CONTAINER?

We recommend washing and reusing plastic containers with large openings for collecting and storing your tabs. Please do not use plastic soda bottles or milk jugs because they are hard to empty!
